The Central East Stroke Network (CESN) Integrated Stroke Program Model: Vision was developed as part of a comprehensive stroke system redesign initiative (2012-2014). It was informed by extensive stakeholder consultation including a Value Stream Mapping event, local community forums and provincial expert consultation. Input was solicited from frontline care providers from across the continuum, administrators, community service providers, caregivers, and people living with stroke. It has been reviewed and updated to reflect emerging best practices. It represents a high-level overview of CESN's vision for an integrated system of stroke care. It is intended to inform planning. It is not a triage tool for clinical decision making nor does it necessarily represent services currently in place in the CESN.
