Life-Participation Approach to Aphasia (LPAA)

LPAA is a service delivery philosophy focusing on re-engaging individuals with aphasia in their lives, prioritizing goals, and maximizing communication participation.

Choose only **one date** based on your **work setting**, all sessions run from 12:00-1:30 p.m. If you cover both areas of the continuum and want to attend each session, please reach out to be added to a waitlist for your second choice - burrridged@rvh.on.ca

Acute/inpatient setting – choose either April 23 or June 10

This session focuses on teaching the core principles of LPAA and A-FROM and applying them to person-centered, functional therapy in acute and inpatient stroke settings. Participants will learn how to identify meaningful treatment priorities within hospital constraints, clarify SLP and CDA roles, and design early intervention plans that support participation, education, and successful transitions of care.

Outpatient/community setting – choose either June 3 or June 17

This session explores how LPAA and A-FROM principles guide long-term, participation-focused therapy in outpatient and community-based stroke services. Participants will apply these frameworks to real-world communication goals, community reintegration, and carryover beyond the therapy room, with practical strategies for collaboration, communication-partner training, and shared SLP-CDA workflows.
